John T. and Samuel Evins McCord, brothers, lived in Lafayette County, MS. John T. McCord was born 1830 in South Carolina. Samuel E. McCord was born in Mississippi and moved to Cass County, TX with some of children and grandchildren around 1910. Located in southeastern Lafayette County, Paris was reportedly first settled in 1836. One of its earliest settlers was Dr. William Lemuel Paris, who built the first home there. according to Hometown Mississippi by Jim Brieger. Dr. Paris also operated a drug store in the area, and within 20 years of his arrival, the town grew to include apost office, a Masonic lodge, and two churches. "One of the earliest and best schools in the country" was located in the Primitive Baptist Church here in the mid-1800s and was run by an Englishman named Winterton. Later, in 1889, the Paris Normal School was established with a goal of preparing students to attend the university. Whether the town was named for Dr. Paris is a matter of some dispute. Another theory is that early settlers came from Paris, Tennessee, and named the Mississippi town in its honor, according to Joan Bratton, a descendant of some early residents. Joan's husband Theron also spent his early childhood in Paris and said he remembers the town as an active community with three stores selling groceries, clothing, and other general wares. He attended the Paris School, which was located near the current intersection of Highways 9 West and 315. Indeed, Paris did thrive at one time. After being officially incorporated in 1873, the town boasted general stores, a blacksmith, and a horse-powered grist mill and cotton gin, according to the Lafayette County Heritage Book. In 1905, a steam-operated cotton gin was built here, and in 1939, the Oxford Eagle proclaimed that many of the town's residents were now enjoying electricity.



1775-1780 Sollomon Crocker Revolutionary War Veteran and Patriot Battle of Cow Pens, S.C Solomon was born in Wake County, Carolina in 1757. The State was soon divided and became South Caroline and Wake became 96 District / Spartanburg County. The Crocker Grant (of Arthur Crocker I, from King George of England dated 1677) covered part of Spartanburg and Union Counties on the Broad, Pacolet rivers and Richland creek. A portion of this land was deeded to Bethesda Church by Solomon. The original homestead site has a log cabin which is still standing. Solomon assisted his father and brothers in their farming and gist mill operations, before the revolutionary war. King George made the colonies Royal Colonies which took the freedom away from the colonies, his Parliament imposed unbearable taxes and other obscenities that made the settlers revolt. Solomon along with his brothers, William, Anthony and James joined the South Carolina militia or rangers, they were known as the "South Carolina Riflemen or Sharpshooters". Solomon was a carpenter as was his father and his father's father. He helped built Fort Seneca in Western South Carolina. He was one of the heroes in the Battles of Cows Pens S.C. Solomon served 5 years during the Revolutionary war in the 1st Regiment of South Carolina Riflemen under Capt. Frank Prince in the First (Fifth) Regiment. He first served at Prince's fort in Spartanburg District, then went to Charleston to assist in repelling Clinton and was stationed at Fort Johnson. He was sent under Col. Roebuck to help construct Fort Seneca. He was discharged and shortly thereafter re-entered the service under Cpt. Robert McWhirter (McWhorter) and was in the battle at Watkins. Patriot Index Supplement : A. A. 1621: X3458: N. A. 853.

May 6, 1780 - The British capture Fort Moultrie at Charleston, South Carolina.

May 12, 1780 - The worst American defeat of the Revolutionary War occurs as the British capture Charleston and its 5400-man garrison (the entire southern American Army) along with four ships and a military arsenal. British losses are only 225.

June 13, 1780 - Gen. Horatio Gates is commissioned by Congress to command the Southern Army. August 16, 1780 - A big defeat for the Americans in South Carolina as forces under Gen. Gates are defeated by troops of Gen. Charles Cornwallis, resulting in 900 Americans killed and 1000 captured. August 18, 1780 - An American defeat at Fishing Creek, South Carolina, opens a route for Gen Cornwallis to invade North Carolina.

October 7, 1780 - Gen. Cornwallis abandons his invasion of North Carolina after Americans capture his reinforcements, a Loyalist force of 1000 men.

October 14, 1780 - Gen. Nathanael Greene, Washington's most able and trusted General, is named as the new commander of the Southern Army, replacing Gen. Gates. Greene then begins a strategy of rallying popular support and wearing down the British by leading Gen. Cornwallis on a six month chase through the back woods of South Carolina into North Carolina into Virginia then back into North Carolina. The British, low on supplies, are forced to steal from any Americans they encounter, thus enraging them January 17, 1781 - An American victory at Cowpens, South Carolina, as Gen. Daniel Morgan defeats British Gen. Tarleton.

March 15, 1781 - Forces under Gen. Cornwallis suffer heavy losses in the Battle of Guilford Courthouse in North Carolina. As a result, Cornwallis abandons plans to conquer the Carolinas and retreats to Wilmington, then begins a campaign to conquer Virginia with an army of 7500 men.

August 27, 1782 - The last fighting of the Revolutionary War between Americans and British occurs with a skirmish in South Carolina along the Combahee River.

February 4, 1783 - England officially declares an end to hostilities in America

April 11, 1783 - Congress officially declares an end to the Revolutionary War.

JAMES MCCORD, BORN 1620, TRADITIONAL SCOTTISH CLAN CHIEFTAIN HAD SEVERAL GRANDSONS WHO CAME BY WAY OF NORTHERN IRELAND TO AMERICA IN 1720-38. THEY SETTLED IN THE LOWER HUDSON RIVER VALLEY OF NEW YORK, NEAR CHARLOTTESVILLE, VIRGINIA, IN BOTH LANCASTER AND YORK COUNTIES, PENNSYLVANIA, AND AT CHARLESTON, SOUTH CAROLINA. THEY LEFT A GREAT HERITAGE, ONE OF REVERENCE FOR GOD, LOYALTY TO COUNTRY, AND LOVE OF FAMILY, THEY AND MANY OF THEIR DESCENDANTS MADE GREAT SACRIFICES THAT WE MIGHT ENJOY FREEDOM AND LIBERTY. TODAY, THEIR DESCENDANTS AROUND THE WORLD HONOR THAT HERITAGE. One of the largest family groups in the American Revolution, over 100 McCords served in most of its major battles. Some 11 McCords were at Valley Forge with General George Washington in the bitter winter of 1777-78. Earlier, McCords were in the French and Indian War where some were killed or taken captive by the French and Indians at Ft. McCord, near Chambersburg, Pennsylvania on April 1, 1756, and held for 1-6 years. Some were recovered in a daring rescue 5 months later by Colonel John Armstrong, Commander of the Frontier Pennsylvania Rangers at Kittanning, near present-day Pittsburgh. Those recovered included Mary McCord. Jean McCord Lowry and her 3 children who were recovered later. For the rescue at Kittanning, Colonel John Armstrong and his Frontier Ranger officers received medals struck in their honor by John Penn of the William Penn Family. Ft. McCord was the most famous private fort in America in the French and Indian War. Most of the McCords in

the American Revolution appear related to a common ancestor in Scotland, Clan Chieftain James MacKorda, who, by strong tradition was born 1620 on the Isle of Skye, Scotland and was killed at the famous Battle of Killiecrankie Pass, Scotland in July 1689. Various other McCords came from other parts of Scotland in the 1600'-1800's. After the Battle of Killecrankie Pass, John McCord, son of the Clan Chieftain, took the remaining members of the McCord family to Ulster, Northern Ireland where they lived until 1720-1740 when many of them moved to America. Several of Clan Chieftain James MacKorda's grandsons who came to America in 1720-1738 settled in Pennsylvania, Virginia, New York and South Carolina. They were William, David, James and John McCord who went to Lancaster County, Pennsylvania: Andrew and Johannes McCord who went to Augusta and Albemarle County, Virginia; John and James McCord who went to the lower Hudson River Valley in New York; and Barnard McCord who went to Charleston, South Carolina. Each of these appear related to the son of Clan Chieftain James MacKorda, John McCord (born 1660), who was married to Mary MacDougall. During the American Revolution, the 100 McCords knew or served with many of the most famous Americans in the Revolution and some in the Continental Congress. By 1790 McCord families pioneering the American frontier were living in 13 states including Maine, New Hampshire, New York, NJ Delaware, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Virginia, North and South Carolina, Georgia, Tennessee and Kentucky. By 1820, there were over 400 McCord families in these states and in Illinois and Indiana, Michigan and Ohio, Arkansas and Alabama, and other areas of the Great West. Most of these McCords appear descended from the original McCord settlers in America of 1720-38. Many of the descendants of these original settlers and those who served in the American Revolution have not yet been traced.

 - David MacKorda was born in 1665 in Argyll, Scotland. He died on 27 Jun 1689 in Argyll, Scotland.
 - iv. James McCord was born in 1666 in Argyll, Scotland. He died on 27 Jul 1689 in Killiecrankie, Perthshire, Scotland.

Notes for Anthony Crocker:

During the 17th century, shortly after establishment of the settlement at Jamestown in 1607, English settlers and explored and began settling the areas adjacent to Hampton Roads. Captain John Smith in 1608 crossed the James River and obtained fourteen bushels of corn from a tribe of Native Americans called Warrosquyoackes. In the next few years, several plantations were established along the shore in the area south of the river. By 1634, the Virginia Colony consisted of eight shires or counties with a total population of approximately 5,000 inhabitants. One of these was Warrosquyoake Shire, renamed Isle of Wight County in 1637, after the island in the English channel of the same name. The name was probably changed due to the difficulty of spelling and pronouncing its Native American name and because the Isle of Wight had been the home of some of the principal colonists. National Historic Landmark, St. Luke's Church, built in 1632, the nation's only original Gothic church and the oldest existing church of English foundation in America is located in the county. In 1732 a considerable portion of the northwestern part of the original shire was added to Brunswick County; and in 1748 the entire county of Southampton was carved out of it.
